Here are some tips for learning French:

Listen – in class and ask questions if you don't understand;

Visualize – the words that you are learning: associate them with sentences and/or pictures;

Practice – Practice alone, with a friend, a sibling, or a parent. Use the following site to help you with pronunciation: http://www.sitepal.com/ttswidgetdemo/;

Speak – participate in class discussion; read <u>aloud</u> 2 or 3 times a week at home. Don't be afraid: read your weekly homework or your lesson, the sentences you wrote in class, the words you learned last Sunday. Hear yourself speak French;

Explore – on the Internet, watch cartoons on YouTube, read the news, listen to the web radio... watch your favorite movie in French.

hAvE fUn en français !

Come to class every Sunday with **a small binder**, **loose-leaf and a pen**. If you choose to write in a notebook, also bring a folder for the printouts, but your homework should be on loose leaf so that it is corrected.

I usually assign homework on a <u>weekly</u> basis. Always review the work done in class before you start your homework: read aloud and write the new words on index cards that you can carry along on the bus or in the car, it is a good exercise to memorize the vocabulary.

I use various books, most published in France but I mostly write my own lessons and exercises. **Please** bring to the next class twenty dollars (\$20) – copy expenses for the year. Thank you!
