Toot, toot, toot-toot-toot.

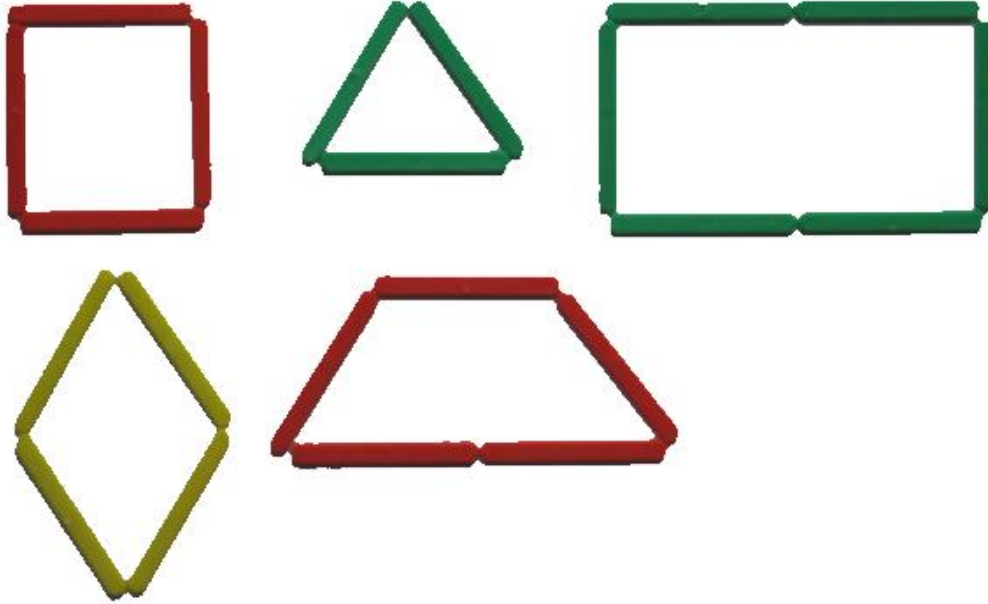
Four girls marching with their bells,

Click, clack, click-clack-click.

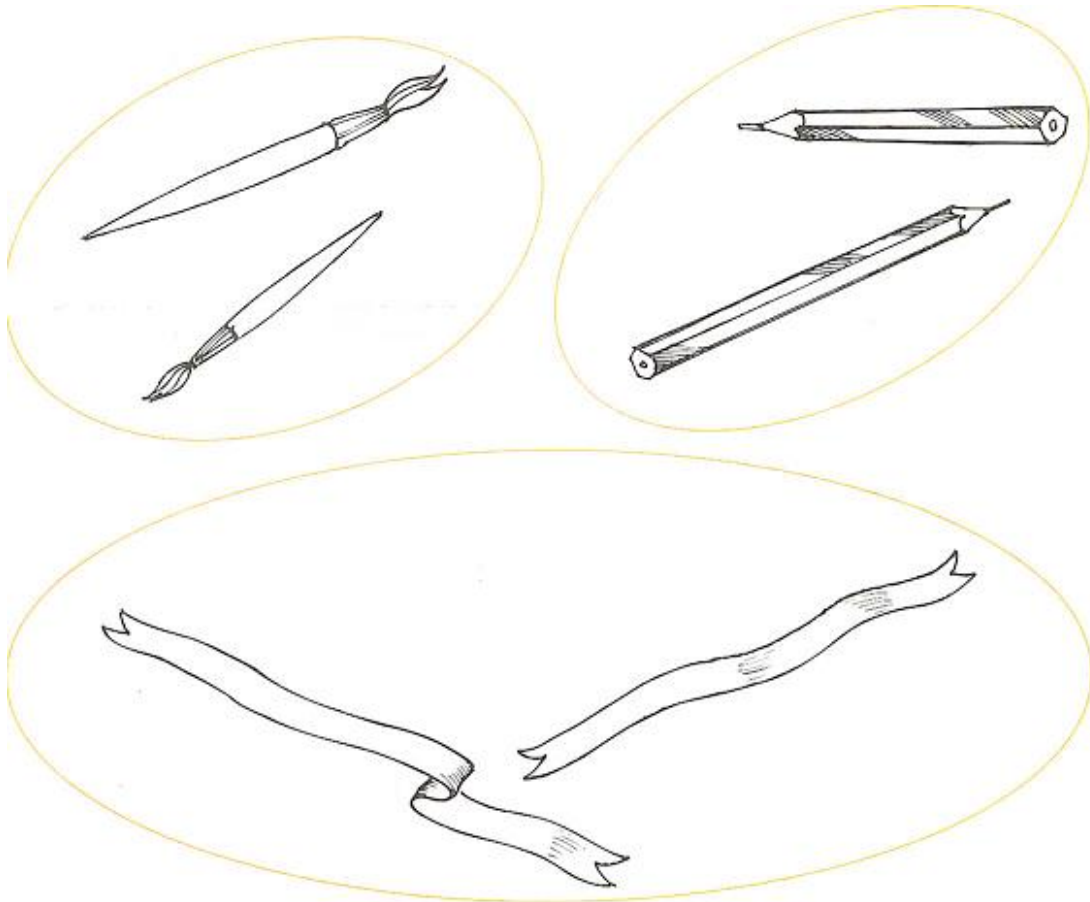
Everyone marching down the street,

Color in the longer objects blue and the shorter yellow.



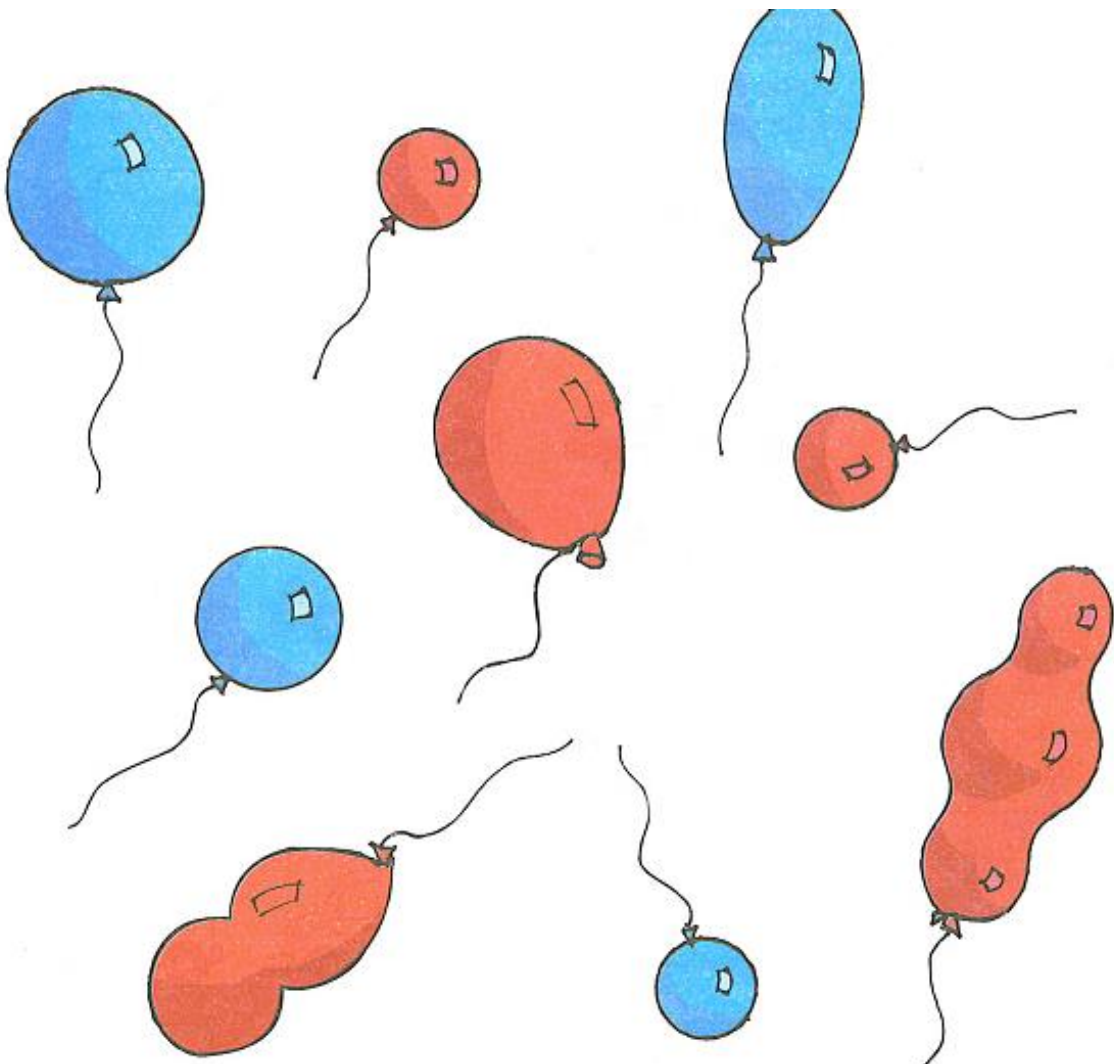
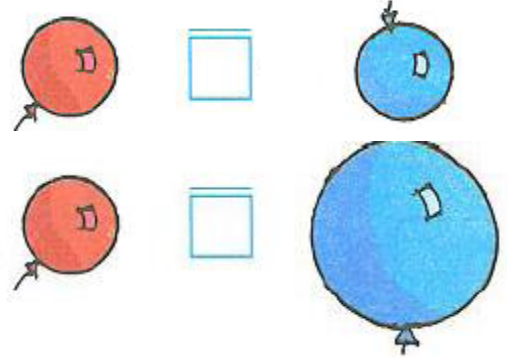
Let's party, said Fred, Help me to decorate our room with balloons.

BLUE BIG balloons

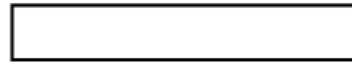
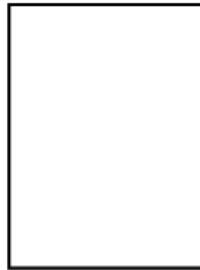
RED SMALL balloons
