
Color the flower in the top left corner red, in the lower right-yellow, lower left -blue, top right-orange. Draw another flower in the middle.




Count the objects and connect the pictures with the matching numbers. In the empty boxes, put the correct number of dots.




Color the matching ski poles the same color.




Put 8 pears onto 2 plates as many ways as possible.




What numbers add up to 8?

How many candies of the same **size** can you put into each vase?




How many candies of the same **color** can you put into each vase?




How many candies of the same **shape** can you put into each vase?
