

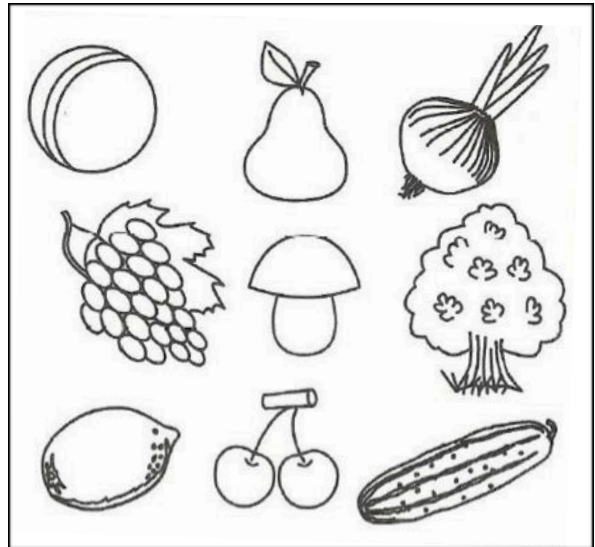

Problem 1

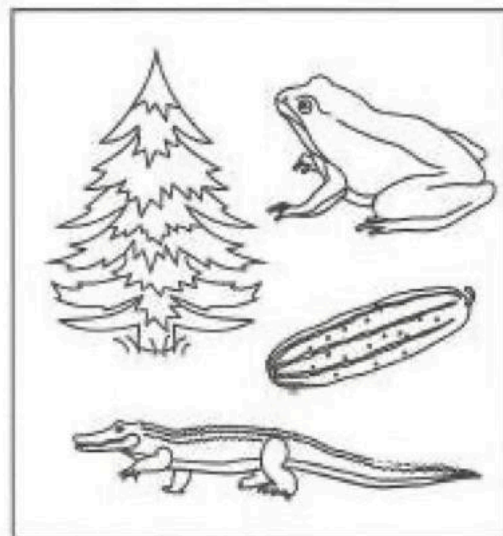
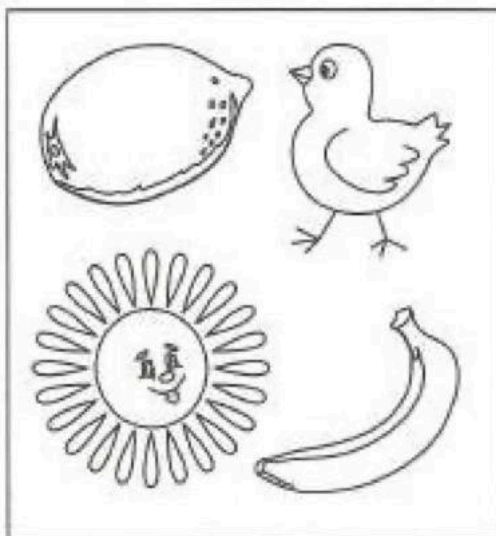
Cross out what does not belong. Can you name a group?

Can you think of any other things that might belong to the same group?



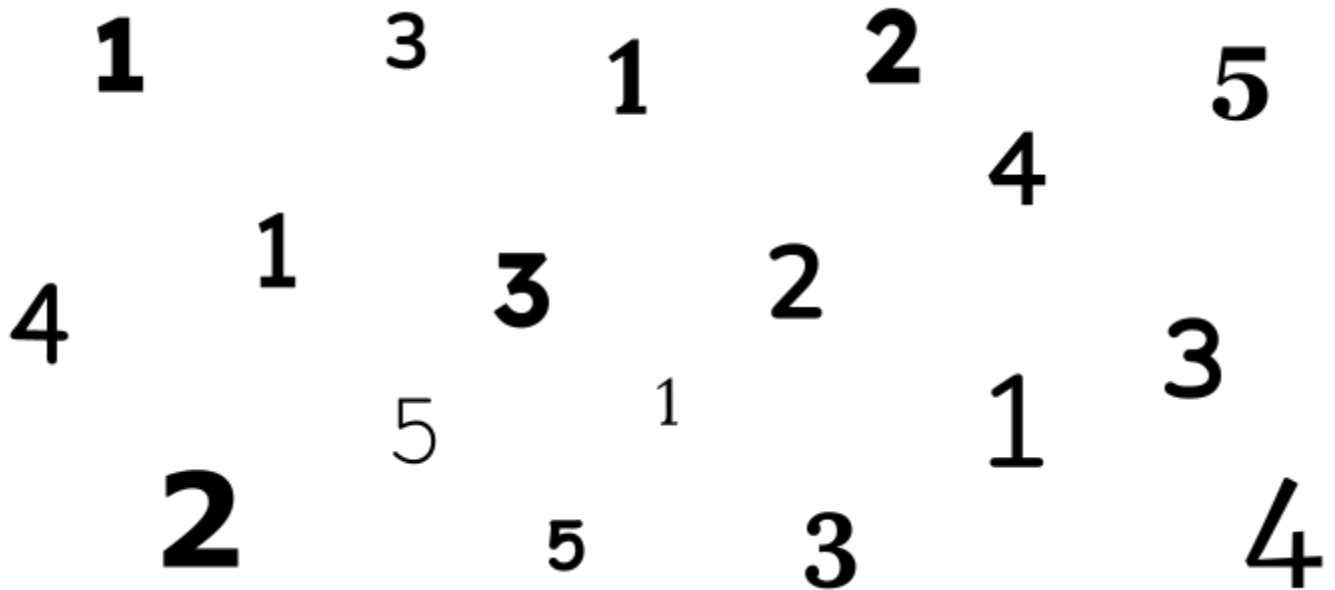
Problem 2

Color each picture with one color. Circle only the objects that have something in common and can be grouped together. Explain why you grouped them.



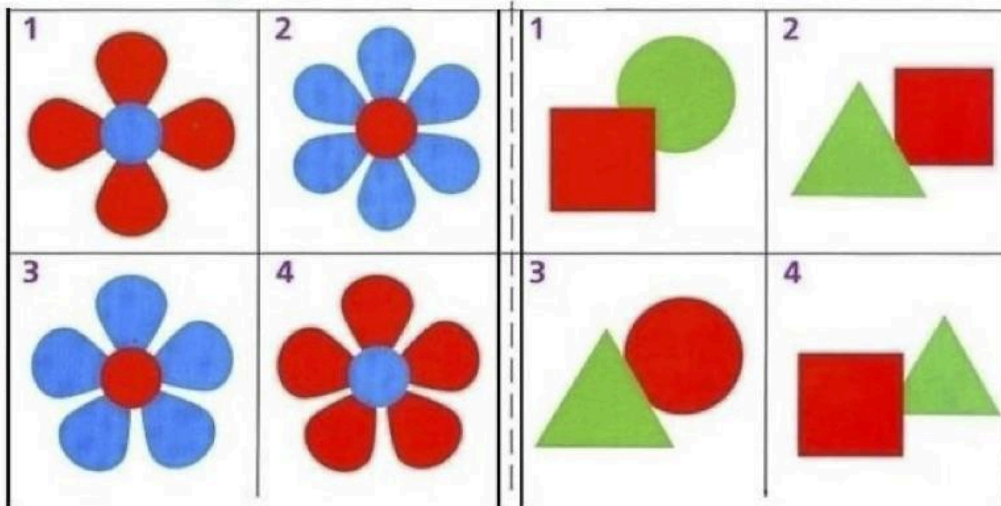
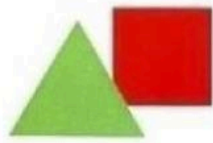
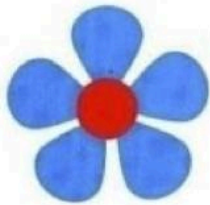
Problem 3
