



#### Problem 1


What needs to be put in the empty boxes? Draw lines.






Our Tanya is crying because she dropped her ball into the lake. The colors washed off the ball. Color the ball.




Draw the cherries so that on the left there is one less cherry than the cherries in the middle and so that there was one more on the right.



Solve the problems. Add and record your answers.




On each string there are **10** beads. Using numbers write how many beads you see and how many are covered.

Each sister has two braids with a bow in each. How many ribbons will they need to take so that they could tie the bows in their hair?








Once the sisters went to the forest to pick mushrooms. They wore high boots and covered their heads with scarves to protect themselves from the ticks. How many boots do they wear together?
