
NAME:

1. Let's explore the <u>tilt of other planets</u> of the Solar System (see picture below).

Earth-like:

EARTH Axis 23.5° Angle To the Sun Ecliptic

2. We very well know two facts:

<u>Fact 1</u>: looking from the Earth, the apparent sizes of the Moon and the Sun are approximately the same.

AND

Fact 2: while orbiting the Earth, the Moon periodically (about once a month) comes in between the Earth and the Sun.

<u>Question</u>: why don't we have a solar eclipse every month?
