

2. The diagram below shows an atom of Hydrogen with some of its possible electron orbits (three energy levels are shown). Electron is currently in its ground state.



- a. Suppose you HEAT the atom. On the diagram, show possible electron transitions (use arrows to indicate where the electron <u>can</u> go).
- **b.** How many emission lines (distinct colors) can this configuration yield? (Remember, the excited electron needs to go to a *lower*, but not necessarily *the lowest*, energy level to emit a photon.)
