Assignment Overview:

You will choose a poet and select one of their poems to analyze. Your task is to explain what you like about the poem and why. You may present your findings in one of the following formats:

- A poster
- ✓ A PowerPoint presentation
- ✓ A one-page essay

Steps to Complete the Assignment:

- 1. Choose a Poet Select a poet you are interested in.
- 2. Select a Poem Pick one of their poems that you enjoy.

3. Analyze the Poem - Think about:

- What is the poem about?
- What words or phrases stand out to you?
- What emotions does the poem make you feel?
- What do you like about the poem?

4. Do Some Research - Find out basic information about the poet:

- Who are thev?
- When and where did they live?
- What kind of poems do they write?

5. Create Your Project - Using your chosen format, include:

- The poem's title and the poet's name
- A short summary of the poem in your own words
- What you like about the poem and why
- Facts about the poet
- (For posters and PowerPoints) Include images or decorations to make it engaging!

Outline for One-Page Essay Option

Title: [Poem Title] by [Poet's Name]

Introduction (3-4 sentences)

- Introduce the poet (Who are they? When and where did they live?)
- Introduce the poem (What is the title? What is it about in one sentence?)
- Write a sentence about why you chose this poem.

Body Paragraph (4-6 sentences)

- Summarize the poem in your own words.
- Describe any words or phrases that stand out to you.
- Explain how the poem makes you feel.
- What is the message or theme of the poem?
- What do you like about the poem?

Conclusion (3-4 sentences)

- Restate the poem's main idea.
- Explain why this poem is meaningful or interesting to you.
- Would you recommend it to someone else? Why or why not?

Tip:

- Use complete sentences.
- Organize your ideas so they flow smoothly.
- Check your spelling and punctuation before turning it in.

- You can include a picture of the poet or a visual that represents the poem's meaning

Slide 6: Conclusion

- Restate the main idea of the poem
- Say one final thought about why you enjoyed this poem.
