(Recall: the Equator is an imaginary line on the Earth's surface which is at equal distance from the North Pole and South Pole.)

Example: Isabela Island (Isla Isabela) of Galapagos, Ecuador

If you do not have a real globe at home, you can use Google Earth 😊 (earth.google.com) just make sure to select the “everything” view in the menu to see the names of all places as well as “turn on gridlines” to see the equator.
