The *Stream* tab only shows announcements. **Homework assignments** are important - do not neglect them. They are part of your learning experience. The more you practice, the better you will be at French.

**Academic honesty:** the use of an online dictionary\* level-appropriate vocabulary is OK, and so is looking up a word in Google. Full sentences should **NEVER** be entered into a translator, not even Google translate. I will know you did it and will not correct your homework. Do your homework to the best of your ability and on your own.

**Materials:** Every student should bring, to each class, a **composition notebook** and a small **binder** (or a **folder**) so that the worksheets are organized in date chronology. Please have your own **pen/pencil and eraser** to write the new vocabulary words. It is a good practice to learn how to spell the words. Come prepared to work with all your materials.
