We may meet only once a week, but that time truly matters. SchoolNova is a place where children think, try, sometimes struggle, and grow — supported by our teachers, teaching assistants, and small but dedicated administrative team, all working together with care and intention.

This year, SchoolNova brought together over 470 students, 44 teachers, and 19 teaching assistants. We offered 92 online and in-person classes across 12 subjects and seven free clubs.

We also run free Advanced Clubs in Math and Physics, where any child who loves solving challenging problems can practice olympiad-level questions and prepare for competitions with world-class instructors.
