My dear students and parents,

Welcome to a new SchoolNova year! My name is Janna Gabinoff and I will be your Math0 teacher. I look forward to making this a wonderful and fun school year.

In this class I will be playing games with the students so that they can learn math but also feel comfortable in the class room.
