PLEASE SUBMIT YOUR WORK THROUGH GOOGLE CLASSROOM

- 1. Make yourself familiar with our Google Classroom.** Login to your SchoolNova Google account, go to Classroom, enter Science class, go over some useful information posted in the stream so far. See if you can access the first Lecture (slides shown today in class) posted under “Classwork” tab. Make sure you know how to turn in your homework.
- 2. Locate Homework #1.** Pay attention to the due date. Open the homework assignment and **comment on it in the space provided** (write something like “Hurray, I found my homework!” or “Did you know the Earth’s a sphere?” 😊). This is how you can easily communicate with me regarding any assignment or material posted; you can choose for your comment to be visible to everybody in the class or just to the teacher (private comment).
- 3. Make yourself familiar with the GoogleSchoolNova website.** Go to <https://schoolnova.org> Locate the “Navigation” box (left side of the page). Click on “Homework” then scroll down to find “Earth Science”. The link will take you to our class page. (Another way to get there: go to “Schedule” then find and click on your particular class.) Now try all links that appear next to the current lesson date, make sure you can access the Lecture and the Homework. **This is an alternative way to see materials. Your completed homework must be submitted through the Classroom anyway.**
- 4. When you are done with the above, go back to the Google Classroom, click on Homework#1 and “turn in” or “mark as done”.** There is no need to attach any work this time.
