

• Power is an amount of work done in unit time:



Remember that *Work= Force *Displacement* Unit of power is called Watt, 1W=1J/s

• You can also use Power to characterize the rate with which heat is produced:



Homework

Problem 1

Find the power of a pump motor that can lift 1 liter (1kg) of water to the height h=10m, in 1 s.

Problem 2

What should be a power of an electric heater that can bring 10 liter (10 kg) of water to the boiling, starting at 20°C, in 3 minutes. Specific heat of water is $4200 \frac{J}{kg \cdot C}$
