
MATH 4: Homework 24

Write the answers on separate sheets of paper, not between the lines.

- 1. There are 25 rows in a theater, 20 seats in each row.
 - a. If all tickets are sold, how many ways are there for all people to sit?
 - b. If only 2 tickets are sold?
 - c. Only 10?
- 2. The rectangle is made up of squares. Find the side length of the largest square if the side length of the smallest square is 1.



3. I drank $\frac{1}{6}$ of a cup of coffee and topped it off with milk. Then I drank $\frac{1}{3}$ of a cup and added more milk. After that, I drank half a cup and filled it with milk again. Finally, I drank a full cup.

So, what did I drink more of — coffee or milk?

4. The length of a rectangle was increased by 40%, and the width was decreased by 40%. By what factor did the new area change?

Reminder: $40\% = \frac{40}{100}$. If the length was a cm, it is now $a + a \times \frac{40}{100}$
