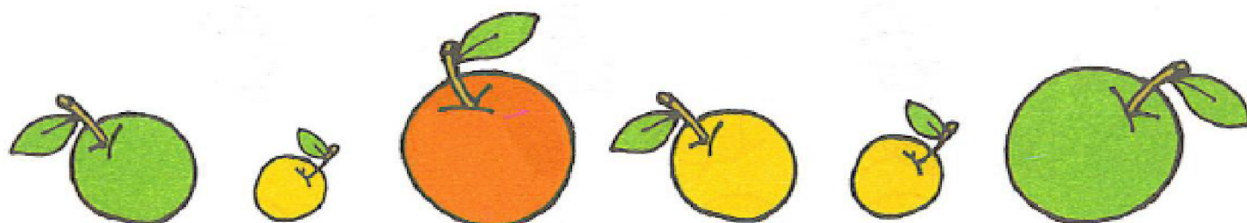

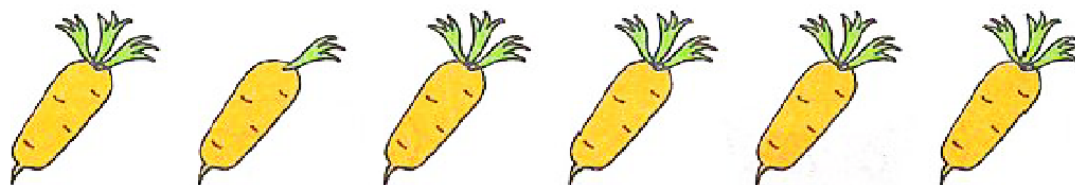
Problem 1

Find apples that are of the same size and connect them with a line.



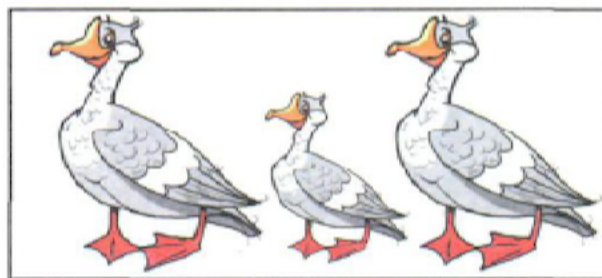
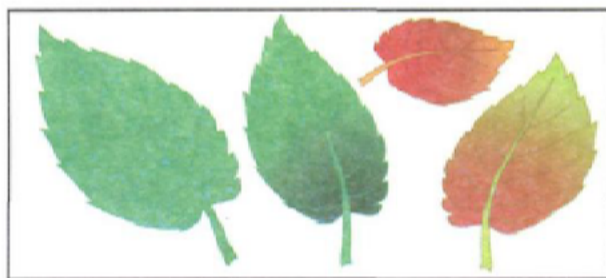
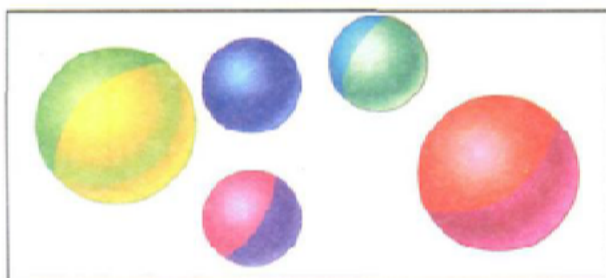
Problem 2

Look at each row below, then circle the object that doesn't belong. Explain why.



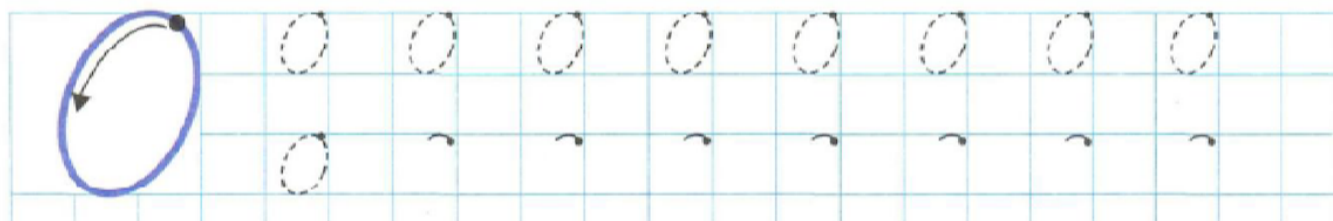
Problem 3

Are there more big objects or small objects?



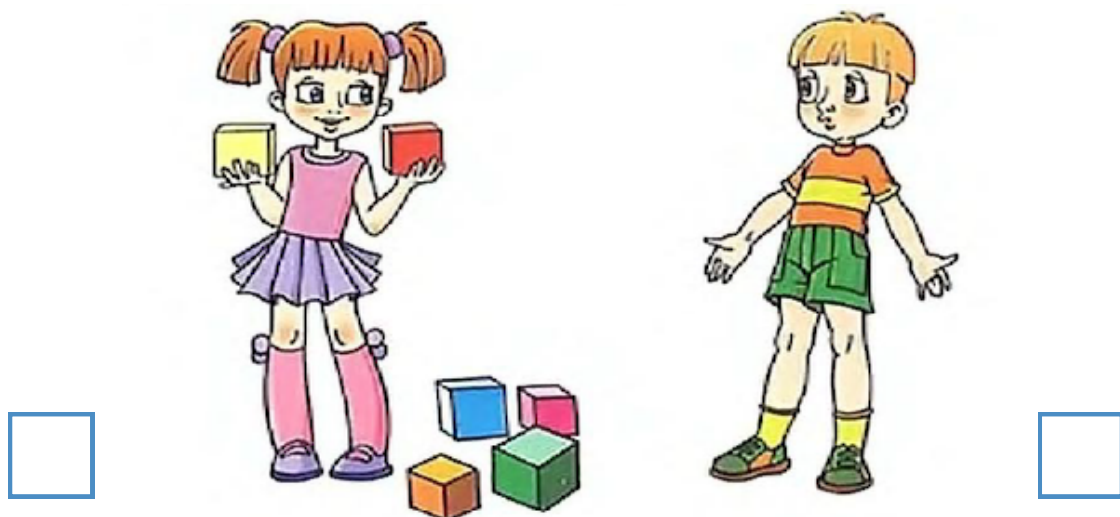
Problem 4

Trace 0 and finish the pattern.

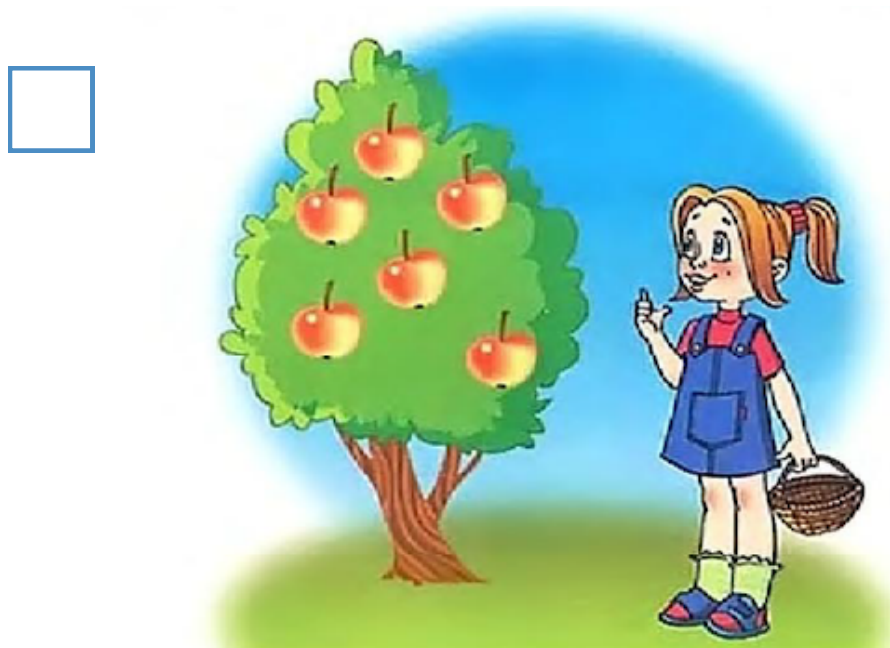


Problem 5

Look at the picture and color:

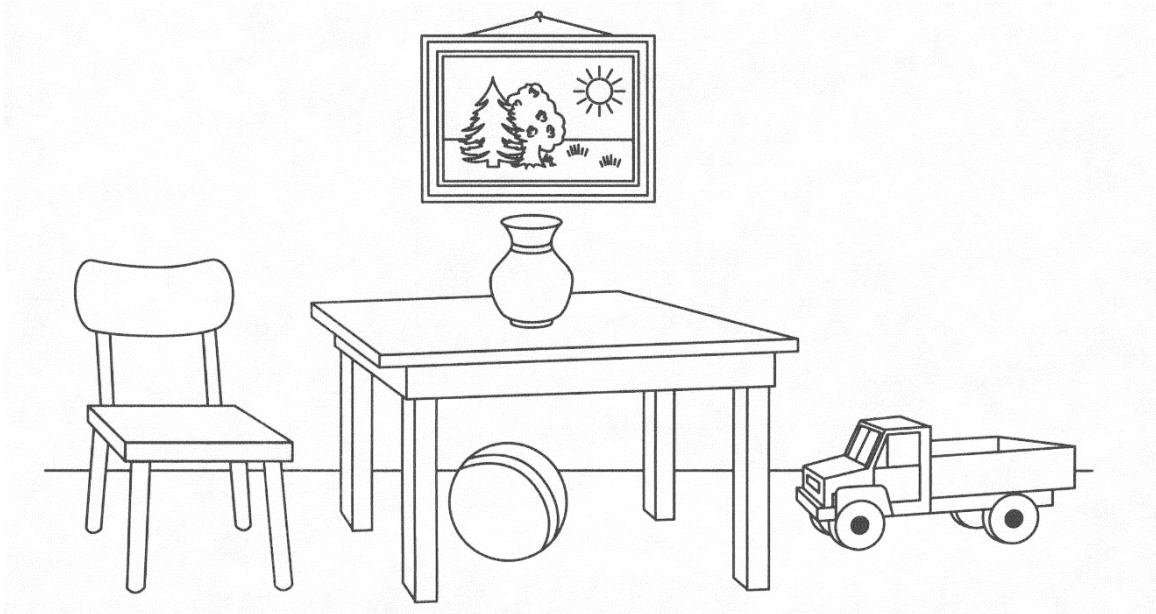
the object that is **“above”** the table in yellow,
